

2007 Ministerial Literacy Awards

In every community, there are educators and organizations that have excelled in promoting literacy and helping people to improve the literacy levels. These awards provide an opportunity to honour the literacy achievements of exceptional educators and organizations across the Northwest Territories.

Who is eligible?

- NWT teachers, tutors or literacy facilitators, who have demonstrated an outstanding dedication to literacy; NWT organizations, literacy committees or programs, which have advocated for literacy and improved literacy levels in their communities.

How many winners will there be?

- One educator, tutor or literacy facilitator and one organization, literacy committee or program.

What do the Ministerial Literacy Award winners receive?

- The award winners will each receive a congratulatory letter, a certificate and a plaque from the Minister of Education, Culture and Employment.

What is the nomination format?

- Fill out the nomination form. At least two letters of support are required. Additional supporting material, such as photographs, audio-visuals, publications and products, will be accepted.
