Local Labour Market Partnerships

Developing a strong Northern workforce

Local Labour Market Partnerships provide financial assistance to **community partners** to identify economic trends and create strategies that address community labour market needs.



Am I Eligible?

To be eligible for Local Labour Market Partnerships funding (LLMP), you must form a partnership with a minimum of 3 of the following, each representing a different community component (including you):

- Business
- Not-for-profit Organization
- Government: Aboriginal, Local, Municipal, Regional, Territorial, Federal
- Public Health or Education Provider
- Community or Special Interest Group
- Board or Agency
- Employee and/or Employer Association

Eligible partners must:

- Each assume an active role and make a significant contribution to the proposed cooperative initiative, either through financial or in-kind contribution
- Submit a proposal that gives a detailed outline of your LLMP initiative

Types of Initiatives

Eligible LLMP initiatives include, but are not limited to:

- Research
Example: Track and assess the community labour market
- Development of Strategic Plans
Example: Prepare a strategic plan to address community economic and employment issues
- Communications
Example: Initiate discussion regarding community challenges and opportunities
- Coordination
Example: Develop local planning group
- Coordination of Work Force Adjustment Strategies
Example: Develop skills and training inventories

Financial Assistance

Financial assistance may include:

- Wages
- Administration costs
- Professional service fees
- Travel costs
- Capital costs

LLMP is not intended to be used as a core funding base.
