Recommend Apprenticeship Level: Understanding the Progressive Exam Process Where an applicant has considerable work experience (more than 1800 hours or approximately one full-time year) in trade, and the support of their employer, they may challenge the first level examination. If they are successful, they will be exempt from Level 1 of Technical Training and begin their apprenticeship at Level 2. Where an applicant has considerable work experience (more than 3600 hours or approximately two full-time years) in trade, and the support of their employer, they may challenge the first level examination. If they are successful, they will be exempt from Level 1 of Technical Training and will be able to challenge the second level examination. If they are successful on both Level 1 and Level 2 exams, they will begin their apprenticeship at Level 3. Your CDO can discuss all of your options for placing the applicant at the appropriate level.
