



Labour Market Recovery Program – Project Fund

What is the Labour Market Recovery Project Fund?

The Labour Market Recovery Project Fund is intended for employers, organizations and community partners looking to implement projects that will have an impact on the recovery of the NWT labour market.

The projects can target:

- capacity building initiatives;
- development of training programs;
- employment creation;
- industry transition support;
- extension of service delivery; and
- initiatives to fill gaps in service and help individuals find work

Project proposals must be submitted before March 31, 2021.

Who can apply?

Registered businesses, industry associations, local housing authorities, non-government organizations, Indigenous organizations, and local, municipal and Indigenous governments are eligible to apply.

How can I apply for the Labour Market Recovery Project fund?

Employers, organizations and community partners must complete a Labour Market Recovery Application form at their ECE Regional Service Centre.

You will also need to provide:

- Proof of legal status
- Proof of liability insurance coverage
- Workers' Safety and Compensation Commission (WSCC) registration
