#### **Am I Eligible?**

#### **Individuals must:**

- · Living with a disability
- Be involved in a learning activity
- Demonstrate commitment to achieving education, employment or personal goals
- Be 18 years of age or older
- Be a resident of the Northwest Territories
- Be unable to get funding for training elsewhere

#### Organizations must be:

- An agency or organization that serves persons living with disabilities
- Licensed to operate in the Northwest Territories
- One of the following:
  - Business
  - Industry Association
  - Local Housing Authority
  - · Non-government Organization
  - · Aboriginal Organization or Government
  - Local or Municipal Government

#### **Application Proposals**

#### To apply, please submit:

- · An application form
- · A proposed budget
- · Vendor quotes for equipment and supplies
- A tutor resume (if applicable)
- Two letters of support

Proposals must show that the financial assistance will help to overcome barriers to learning.

#### **Financial Assistance**

### Funding may be provided for the following types of learning supports:

- · Assessment and counselling
- Assistive devices, aids and technology
- Books, tools and equipment
- Assisted learning
- Tutoring services
- Tuition
- Transportation
- · Living expenses

Financial assistance is provided on an annual basis beginning April 1st.

Applications are received and reviewed throughout the year on a first come, first served basis.

A final written report and financial statement is required at the end of the project.
