

# 2019 NWT EDUCATION HALL *of* FAME

## Information on the Nomination Process

Annually, individuals in the NWT are inducted into the Education Hall of Fame. One Minister's Choice Award recipient will also be inducted. Nominations are accepted from any resident of the Northwest Territories. The successful nominees are selected by a committee comprised of one representative each from the Department of Education, Culture and Employment (ECE), the Northwest Territories Teachers' Association (NWTTA) and from education Superintendents. The Committee will be chaired by ECE's Assistant Deputy Minister, Education & Culture.

### Purpose

To recognize and celebrate those who have provided exemplary service or assistance in the field of education.

## Nomination Package

All nomination packages must contain the following items:

- One letter of support and/or reference
- Signature from the nominee indicating that they are aware of the nomination or signature from the nominator indicating that the nominee is aware of the nomination
- Personal contact information for both the nominee and the nominator

The deadline for all nominations is May 10, 2019.

## Conditions

Prior to submitting nominations packages, the conditions below must be met by all nominees:

- Must be a current resident of the Northwest Territories for at least five years, or must have been a resident for more than 15 years if currently residing outside the NWT
- Must have made a significant, long-term contribution to education in the NWT
- Must be independently motivated by a genuine desire to make a difference

## Minister's Choice Selection Process

Each year, the Minister of Education, Culture and Employment may select a Minister's Choice Award recipient at his or her discretion. This decision may be made independently of the scoring selection process.

## Criteria and Scoring Scale

Criteria	Description	Weight	Score
<b>Contribution to the Profession</b>	How the individual has contributed to the teaching and learning environment of the learning community	<b>10</b>	<b>/10</b>
<b>Leadership</b>	How the individual or has demonstrated leadership combined with a contribution to education	<b>10</b>	<b>/10</b>
<b>Supporting Indigenizing Education</b>	How the individual has supported and encouraged indigenous cultures and languages	<b>10</b>	<b>/10</b>
<b>Letter of Support</b>	How the individual has impacted an individual, school, colleagues and community	<b>10</b>	<b>/10</b>
<b>Contribution to Community</b>	How the individual has been involved, supported or led community based activities	<b>10</b>	<b>/10</b>
