* A Trade Qualifier (TQ) is a person who meets the jurisdictional requirements to write the certification examination. Requirements include:

- On-the-job work experience of at least (1800) hours more than a typical Apprenticeship term
- Documentation of work skills that have been verified by a certified journeyperson in the trade. Documentation must also include verification of hours.
