



## 2022/23 Mentor-Apprentice Program (MAP) Application Form

The goal of the Mentor-Apprentice Program (MAP) is to help develop new fluent Indigenous language speakers. Fluent speakers (Mentors) are partnered with committed learners (Apprentices) in an immersion environment in a home or on the land.

This will be a one-on-one language immersion program. The Mentor and Apprentice will spend about 7-10 hours per week together doing everyday activities while speaking their Indigenous language. It is anticipated that the learners will become more fluent in their language.

Both Apprentice and Mentor will receive an hourly salary (up to 200 hours) for their efforts.

### Eligibility

All adults 18+ are eligible for the MAP program if they meet the criteria. Priority will be given to Indigenous applicants that reside in the Northwest Territories and those with a demonstrated commitment to share the language with others upon completion of the program. This includes teachers, childcare workers, parents, or those actively engaged in language programming in their community.

### Program Timeline

1. Application submission deadline: **May 1, 2022**
2. Application review by MAP Selection Team: **May 2 – 20, 2022**
3. Interviews for applicants who are selected for consideration: **May 24 – June 24, 2022**
4. MAP pairs who are selected for the program notified: **June 30, 2022**
5. Training: **August 2022**
  - Attendance is mandatory for all MAP pairs.
  - Travel and accommodation costs will be paid for by the GNWT.
  - Daily expense allowance will be paid upon completion of the training workshop.
  - Mentor honoraria will be paid upon completion of the training workshop.  
*Please note: Apprentices will not be paid an honoraria.*
6. MAP Delivery Period: **September 2022 to March 2023**
  - Mentor and Apprentice begin their language immersion sessions immediately after the two-day training workshop.

1. MAP Application must include a 1-2 page **letter or video of intent** from the Apprentice. The letter or video should clearly outline your commitment to your language and interest in the program. The following additional information is particularly valuable:
  - Why you want to learn your language;
  - Why do you think the MAP program will work for you;
  - Specific intentions to pass on the language.
2. MAP Application must include a 1-2 page **resume** of the Apprentice.
3. MAP Application must include one **letter of support** for the MAP pair. This letter is ideally written from a respected community member, local official, or educational leader. The letter should *not* be from an immediate family member.

### Section G: Training Workshop

A mandatory training workshop will be held for MAP pairs in August 2022. In order to participate in the program both the Apprentice and Mentor must attend the workshop. Travel to another community or regional centre may be required for the workshop.
