Introduction

The Ndilo District Education Authority (NDEA) was established under the *Education Act* of the government of the Northwest Territories by order of the Minister. Its purpose is to administer and maintain the standards of educational programs defined under the Act in the member community of Ndilo. The first NDEA board was elected on May 29, 2013 and served a three year term. The second NDEA board was acclaimed on May 02, 2016 as seven community members put forth nomination papers and no election was necessary. Our current Chairperson is Lila Erasmus, Vice-Chairperson is Rose Black and the other members include: Cecilia Beaulieu, George Goulet, Monica Godard, Nyra Mackenzie and Muriel Betsina.

- K'alemi Dene School – grades Junior Kindergarten – 12
- Enrollment has been steadily increasing with 102 FTE in 2014/15 and 116.5 FTE in 2015/16.
- We will have 21 employees for the 2016/17 school year. Of these 18 are Yellowknife School District 1 (YK1) and 3 are Yellowknives Dene First Nation (YKDFN) employees. Employee services are contracted out to both of these organizations from the NDEA.
- YK1 is contracted to provide Superintendent services.
- YKDFN is contracted to maintain accounting services.

Programs and Services

Administration - The administration section includes a budget for salaries and benefits for NDEA staff, honoraria for NDEA members and administration O&M expenses.

School Programs - This section includes a budget to operate the school system such as salaries and benefits for classroom teachers, consultants, school counselors, secretaries and custodians. It also covers materials and supplies for the classroom and student transportation.

Inclusive Schooling - The budget for inclusive schooling is to provide support systems and services to enable all students to be included as full participants in regular, age-appropriate classes. This includes salaries and benefits for inclusive schooling consultants, program support teachers our literacy coach and education assistants.

Aboriginal Language and Cultural Based Education Programs (ALCBE) - The budget for ALCBE supports the teaching and learning centers and salaries and benefits for the ALCBE Coordinator, Educational Assistant (.5) and additional cultural staff.

Facilities and Maintenance - The budget for facilities and maintenance covers additional maintenance requirements that are not covered by the GNWT.

Budget Overview and Highlights

The Department of Education, Culture and Employment provides the majority of revenue for the NDEA. Total expected revenue is \$2,182,969 and the projected expense is \$2,430,570. This leaves a projected operating deficit of \$247,601. This funding will come from our current surplus.

Budget highlights:

- Full-time Literacy Coach
- Small classroom sizes (under 20)
- Specialty teachers including music and physical education
- Full-time ALCBE Coordinator with daily Wiliideh Yatii classes
